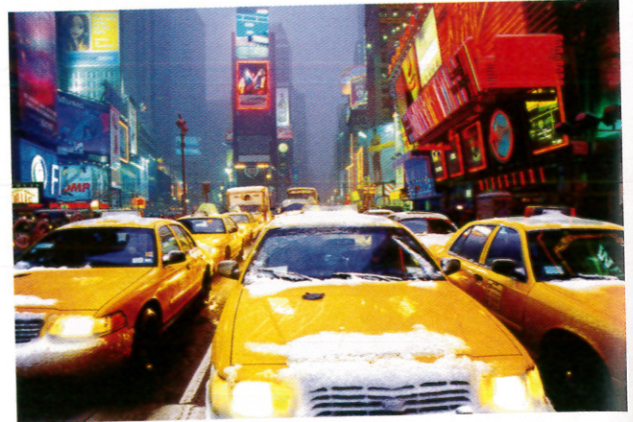


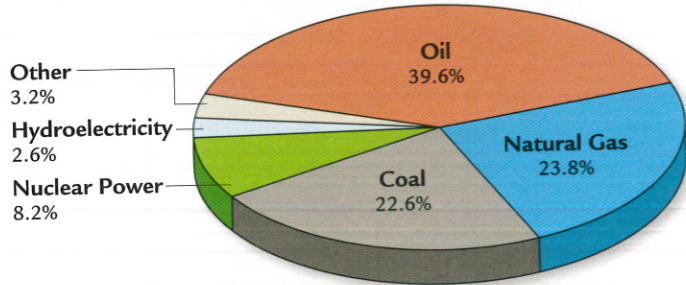


Wind power is a clean energy source that is inexhaustible. However, it is only commercially useful in areas that have strong, steady winds. Only about 0.12 percent of electric power in the United States is produced by wind.
