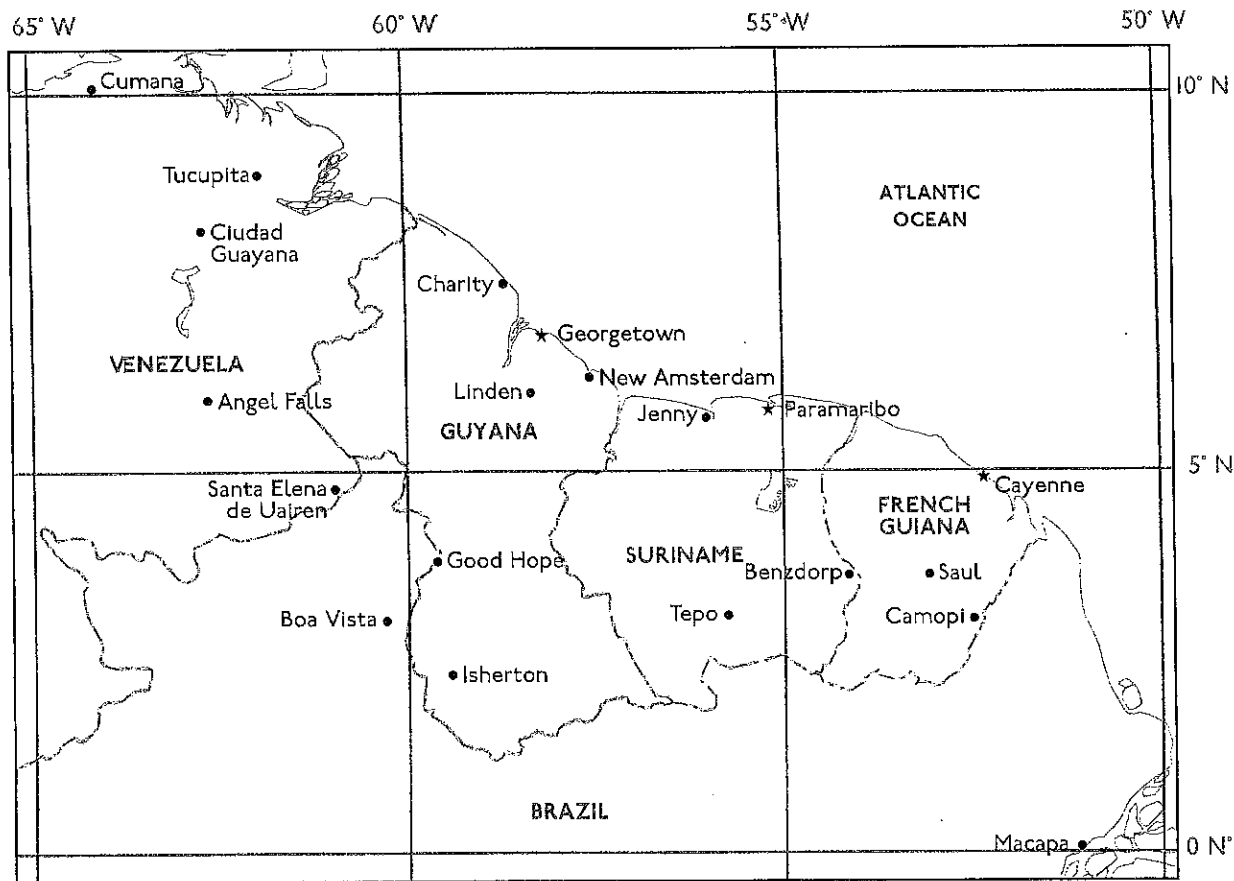


PLOTTING SOUTH AMERICAN CITIES

Write the coordinates for each city in the blanks. The first one has been done for you.

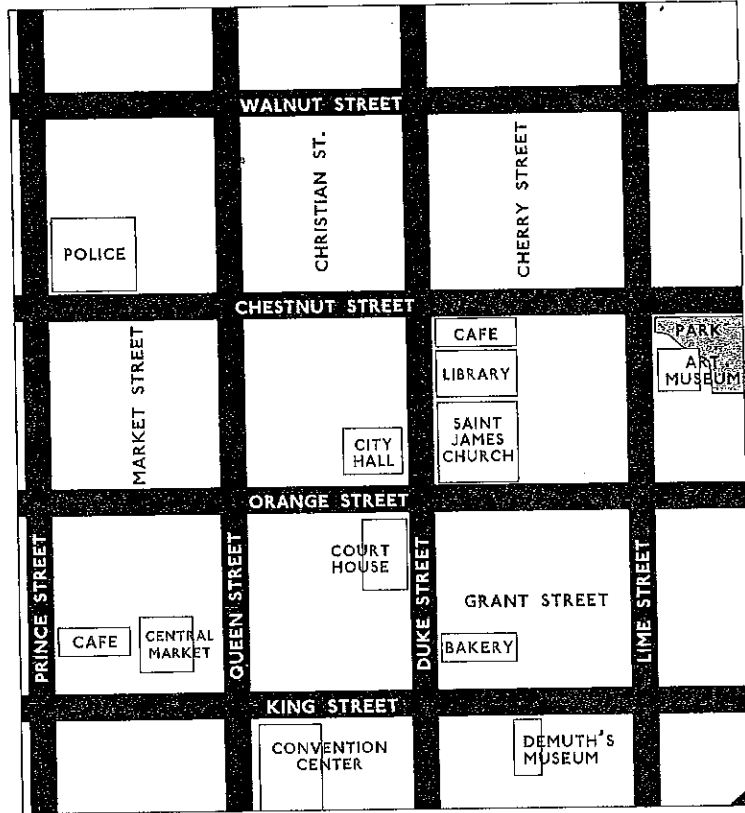

LANCASTER, PA

Originally called Hickory Town, Lancaster was home to James Buchanan, the nation's 15th president, and was the capital of the colonies on September 27, 1777, when the Continental Congress fled Philadelphia after it had been captured by the British. Lancaster has the oldest, continuously run farmers market and theater in the United States. The Fulton Opera House on Prince Street was named for Lancaster native Robert Fulton, who created the first fully functional steamboat. Lancaster manufactured the Conestoga wagon, the Pennsylvania long rifle, and the first battery-powered watch—released in 1957 by the Hamilton Watch Company.
