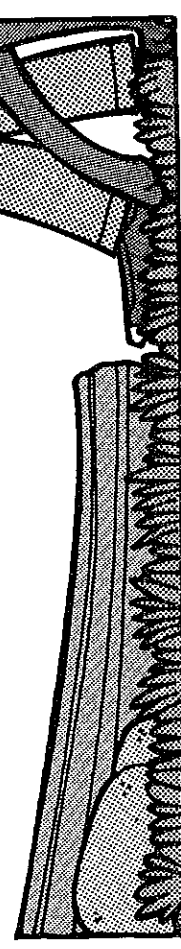


### Suzannah, the Spy for the FBI

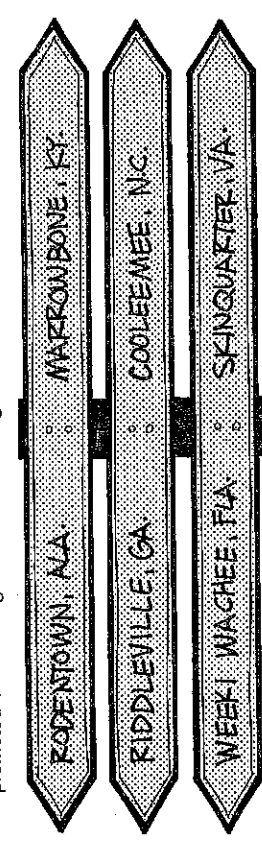

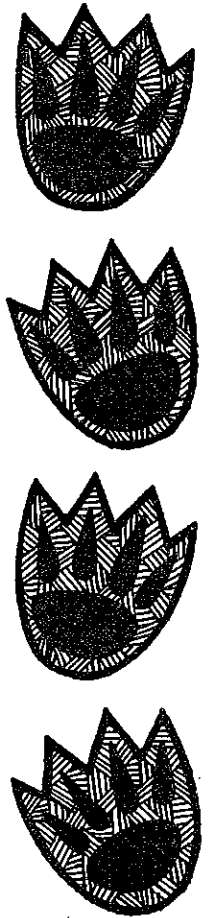

As you use each place in the box, cross it off. If you complete the sentences correctly, the last place will be the one in which the northeast beast is hiding.

- Brenda begins her perilous adventure in \_\_\_\_\_, a city that is the home of the Statue of Liberty, Central Park, and the United Nations. Its nickname is the "Big Apple."
